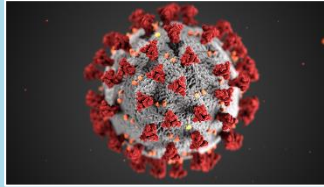

COVID-19 Testing at Wyandot Memorial Hospital

If you think you **HAVE** COVID-19:

Respiratory Illness Clinic

People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

cough • shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
fever • chills • muscle pain • sore throat
new loss of taste or smell

1. Call your medical provider for a phone assessment and triage; or if you don't have a provider, phone WMH's UrgentCare at 419-294-4991, extension 2126
2. Your medical provider or UrgentCare may refer you to the hospital's Respiratory Illness Clinic if an in-person respiratory assessment is indicated
3. The Respiratory Illness Clinic in the WMH Emergency Department parking lot is open Mon-Fri from 9 am-3 pm – *Please remain in your vehicle for staff to assist you*

If you think you **HAD** COVID-19:

Antibody Testing - \$60

A blood test to look for COVID-19 antibodies in the blood, which means there has been a **previous** infection

WMH offers Antibody Testing for COVID-19 as a special outreach project, so no physician's order is needed and no insurance plans will be billed

1. Pre-registration for antibody testing is required by phoning WMH patient registration at 419-294-4991, extension 2291
2. Use the lab's drive-thru service open weekdays Mon-Fri 7 am-5 pm in the WMH Emergency Department parking lot
3. Lab Staff will report to your vehicle for the blood draw
4. Results will be available 24 hours after the blood draw, and participants may (a) view their results remotely on the patient portal, (b) have them mailed to their address or (c) phone WMH Population Health and Wellness staff at 419-294-4991, extension 2171, to schedule in-person pick up

0-1 Indicators met; or low incidence threshold of under 10 cases per 100,000 over a two-week period.	2-3 Indicators met.	4-5 Indicators met; or if previously at Level 3 , a county stays at Level 3 until it drops below the high incidence threshold of over 100 cases per 100,000 over a two-week period.	6-7 Indicators met for two consecutive weeks. The county will remain at Level 3 and be on a watch list the first week.

Patient appointments with medical providers are conducted in person or via phone or telemedicine – <i>if you have an appointment and are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, please phone the office for guidance</i>			
Drive-thru lab draws <ul style="list-style-type: none"> provided at the Emergency Department parking lot Mon-Fri 7 am-5 pm pre-register for lab services by phoning 419-294-4991, extension 2291 & staff will report to your vehicle for the lab draw

Cafeteria & Beca House North closed to the public – open only for carry-out to patients, their visitors & staff
