Patients

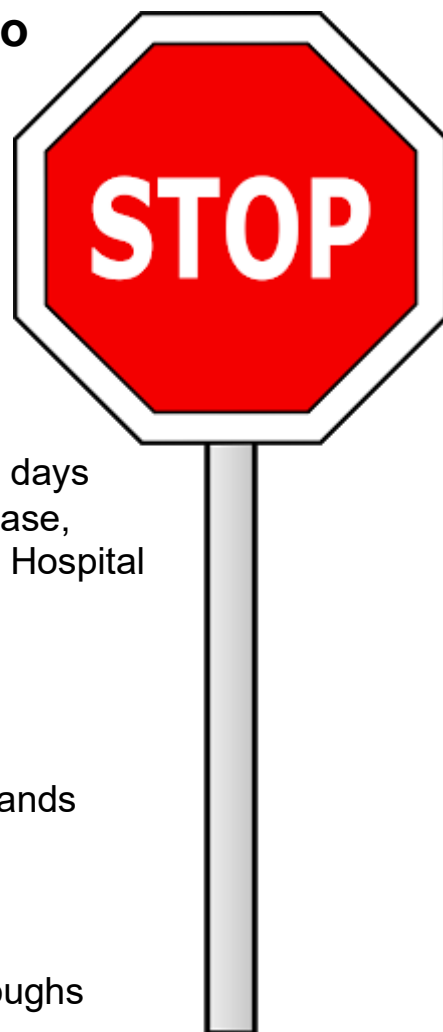
- Our staff will ask you

- If you are feeling ill, please do not visit your family and friends at the hospital
- Practice disease prevention, especially washing your hands and covering your cough
