- JOB DUTIES:** Assist therapy services and nursing department in daily treatments of rehab and swingbed patients. Transfers and transports patients as directed by therapy or nursing services. Coordinates swingbed patient's daily therapy schedule under direction of PT/OT and nursing services. Assists therapists with patient exercises and functional activities; performs clerical duties (including answering phone; messaging; forms completion; supply and inventory functions; maintaining equipment including assembly and disassembly; changing bed linens; assisting patients with personal care including, but not limited to, dressing/undressing; applying/removing supportive devices such as braces, splints, slings, etc.; bathing; feeding; toileting; etc. Performs various other patient care activities and related non-professional services necessary in caring for the personal needs and comfort of our patients as assigned. Other duties as assigned and acts as a communications liaison between therapy and nursing departments.
