A TRADITION

Caring for the health of our community

Wyandot Memorial Hospital was built by the people and for the people. Prior to opening its doors in September 1950, voters in Crane, Mifflin, Pitt and Salem Townships passed bond issues to fund building a hospital in Wyandot County. Those dollars were bolstered by personal donations and federal funds provided by the Hill-Burton Act of 1946.

The original structure featured a capacity of 35 beds. Several additions and renovations were completed over the years to meet the growing needs of patients. Some of the construction was paid for with tax dollars from the four townships, while other projects funded with federal grant monies, operational savings restricted for reinvestment and generous donations from individuals and organizations.

The 1991-92 addition and renovation project was the last bond issue put before voters, and that obligation was paid in full in 1997. Since that time, voters in our four townships have not paid property taxes for hospital improvements, and hospital leadership has worked hard to balance mission with good business and strong finances.

As many area hospitals were forced to join large health systems in recent years, Wyandot Memorial has remained an independent, joint township district hospital ... one of only a handful in the state. The citizen-owners of WMH can be proud that their Joint Township Board of Trustees, Board of Governors and Foundation Board collaborate with the medical staff, employees and volunteers in providing superior compassionate healthcare to all and in striving to be our community's first choice for healthcare.

Focusing on patients has enabled Wyandot Memorial to grow from a small rural hospital to a main campus with off-site medical offices both nearby and in neighboring villages. The acquisition of Koehler Drug and our local Home Health and Hospice further builds on the tradition of exceptional care, exceptional service ... every patient, every time.

The mission of Keeping Our Promise to be Your Hospital is a reminder of the pledge shared in a patient handbook years ago:

*“With your admission to our hospital, you become our guest as well as our patient. The primary interest of everyone connected with this institution is that your recovery will be accomplished soon, and that your stay will be as pleasant as possible. Our personnel, our facilities, our services are at your disposal. Since you are now our patient, this becomes **“your”** hospital. We hope that you will ever consider it such.”*

NEW SERVICES

Licensed Massage Therapist Cari Corfman is now providing massage therapy at Wyandot MedSpa, a department of Wyandot Memorial Hospital.

Corfman brings extensive experience in the field to MedSpa, as she has been in private practice in the area since 2007.

“Most people think of massage as a luxury,” she noted, “but in reality it has been around for over 3,000 years and used around the world as a healing for the mind, body and spirit.”

Corfman said research indicates massage therapy can help manage some common ailments, including chronic pain, delayed onset muscle soreness, anxiety, stress, soft tissue injuries, insomnia, fibromyalgia and headaches.

“One of the immediate benefits of massage therapy is a feeling of deep relaxation and calm,” she explained. “Additionally, massage therapy improves circulation, joint flexibility and mobility; reduces stress hormones and muscle tension and stimulates the lymphatic system.”

The Mohawk alum graduated from the American Institute of Massage Therapy in Tiffin and provides several types of specialized therapies to address specific health concerns:

Swedish Massage

Swedish Massage promotes relaxation by applying oil or lotion with long gliding strokes to warm the skin, then kneading, vibration, tapping and percussion to help relieve muscle tension, improve circulation, reduce the symptoms of anxiety and depression and instill an overall sense of wellbeing.

Deep Tissue Massage

Deep Tissue Massage helps release muscle tension in the connective tissue and fascia by using a combination of firm slow movements, cross fiber friction, trigger point therapy and stretching to address chronic pain.

Hot Stone Massage

Hot Stone Massage adds warm basalt stones to a Swedish massage. The warmth of the stones is comforting, relaxing and adds depth to the benefits of a regular massage.



Prenatal Massage

Prenatal Massage aids in reducing the stress, anxiety, muscle aches, pains and swelling associated with pregnancy, and can also help in regulating hormones.

Cupping

Cupping uses specific suction cups placed on the skin to help reduce pain, improve blood flow, decrease muscle tension and relieve trigger points, and can be added to a regular massage. The cupping technique can leave a circular bruise on the skin from bringing new blood flow to the surface.

Aromatherapy

Aromatherapy incorporates aromatic essential oils into a massage to help boost mood and relaxation, and reduce anxiety and depression, muscle tension, headaches, sinus issues and joint pain.

Massage Gun

Massage Gun targets muscle tension with percussion and vibration.

Corfman offers sessions of 30, 60 or 90 minutes.

“The 30-minute sessions are great for a quick fix from a headache; sinus issues; and neck, shoulder or back pain; or to help ease muscle cramps of the legs and feet and increase circulation by targeting just those areas,” she explained.

The 60-minute sessions give individuals more time to relax and enable Corfman to target trouble spots or issues, and 90-minute sessions provide for deeper relaxation to address chronic muscle aches and pains.

“I talk one-on-one with massage clients to determine their health needs, learn of any medical concerns and discuss their goals for the treatment,” Corfman explained. “This time together enables us to create a plan for therapy and make adjustments during the course of treatment accordingly.”

Corfman is available by appointment at MedSpa on weekdays, Thursday evenings and some Saturdays. For more information or to schedule, phone MedSpa at 419-294-2758.

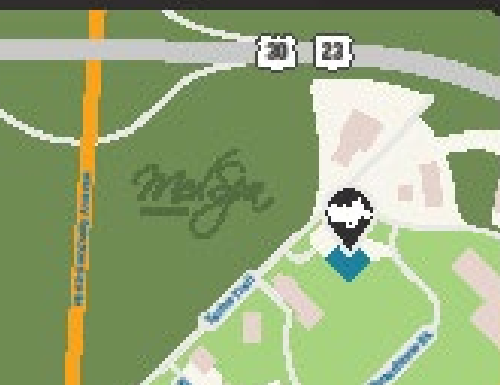

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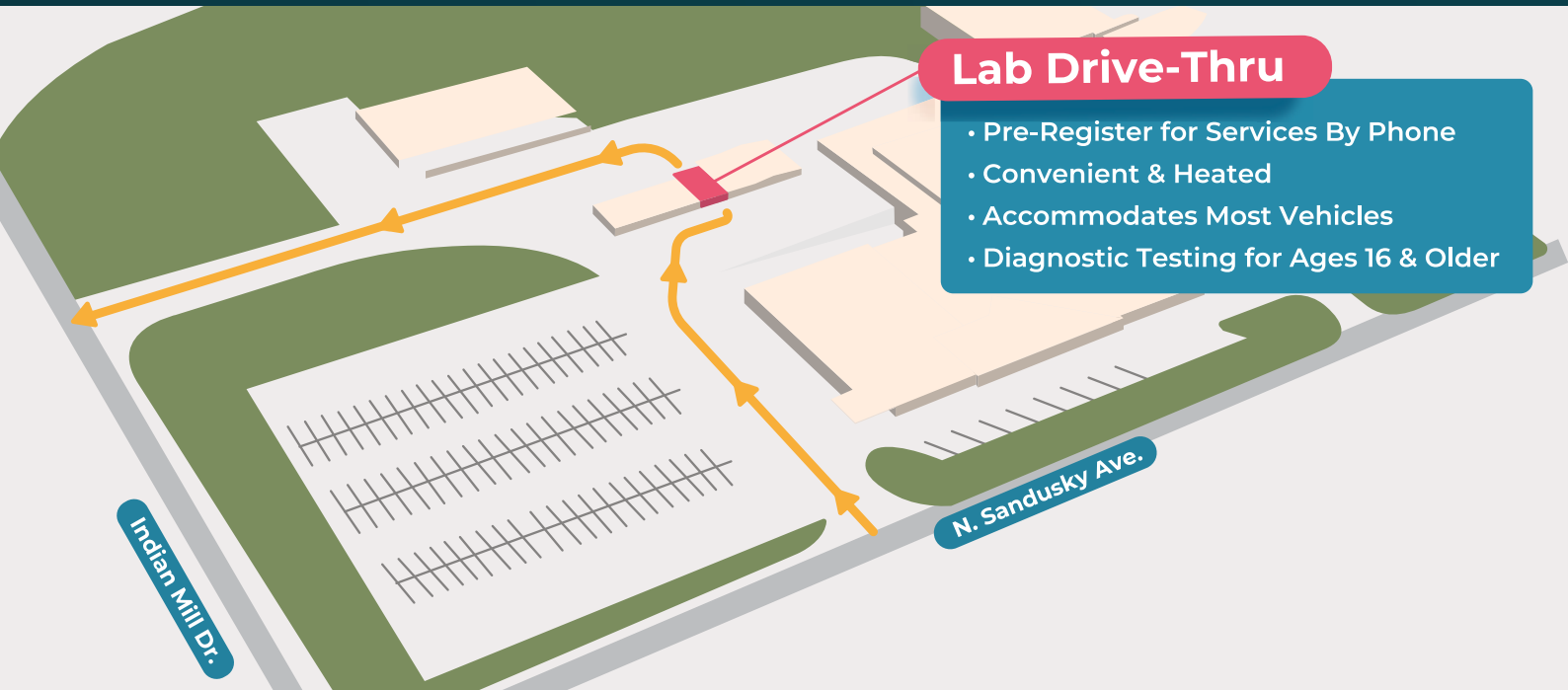

The permanent lab drive-thru at Wyandot Memorial Hospital is open for patients in need of ordered blood work or community health screenings.

The lab drive-thru is situated behind the new surgery center expansion and easily accessed via the hospital's drive near the water tower. Yellow signs direct patients to the drive-thru and provide instructions for entering.

The drive-thru is open Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and serves patients ages 16 and older.

Patients pre-register for lab services by phoning 419-294-4991, extension 2291, prior to their visit to the drive-thru. The service is first come, first served, and no appointments are needed. For the safety of both patients and staff, pets

should not be in vehicles at the drive-thru.

In addition to the drive-thru, patients can have blood work at the lab office on the main floor of the hospital and on Wyandot On Wheels community visits to Carey, Forest, Harpster, Nevada and Wharton.

The drive-thru labs at WMH started near the beginning of the coronavirus pandemic to minimize the number of individuals needing to enter the hospital for services. It enabled patients to remain in their vehicles while the lab staff reported to them for the blood draw. The service received rave reviews from patients of all ages for the convenience it provided, so it was decided to make the drive-thru permanent.

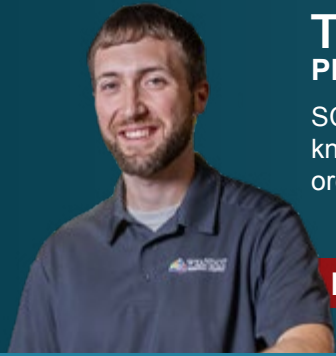

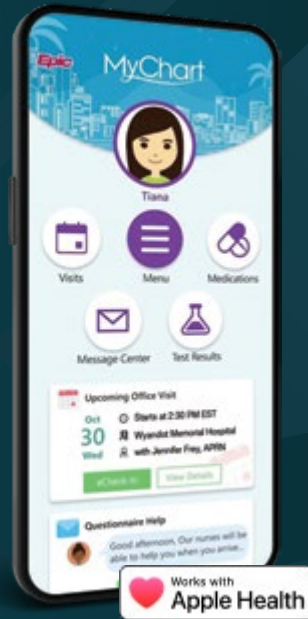

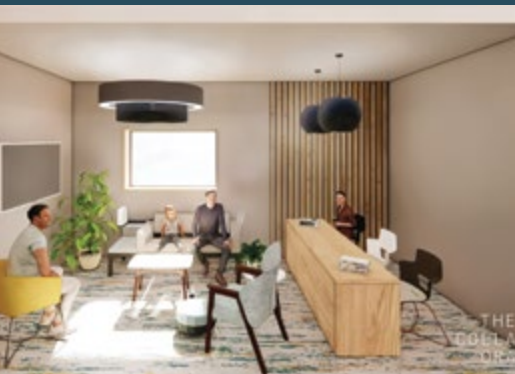
